





HOW WILL YOU PROTECT YOUR RIG SITE FROM OLD MAN WINTER?

Winter weather can have a major impact on oil field housing operations. Fluids freeze, parts become brittle and electrical circuits become burdened. Every remote rig site should have a detailed winterization plan to ensure all key systems and components are properly insulated for winter conditions.





4 KEY TIPS IN PROTECTING YOUR RIG SITE HOUSING FROM HARSH WINTER CONDITIONS



ISSUE: Sometimes our heat trace is unplugged from the outlet to make room for an engine block heater. Make sure all lines are plugged in.

SOLUTION: If a line was unplugged, plug in and the line should thaw shortly.



ISSUE: Due to extra electrical power demands in the winter, a GFCI may trip and no longer provide power to a heat trace line, pump heater or the pump itself.

SOLUTION: If a GFCI has tripped, push the REST button and power should return to assist in thawing out any lines that froze in the absence of power. If a GFCI continues to trip, please call our service department.



ISSUE: The toilet seems to be backing up and not flushing. This could be a sign that the GFCI has tripped or the lift station outside of the skid house is frozen.

SOLUTION: Check the GFCI associated with the pump to ensure it is working and the pump and heater are plugged in. If the unit is frozen and the pump heater seems to have no effect on the frozen fluids, please call your local service department.



ISSUE: The skid house doesn't seem to be getting warmer.

SOLUTION: Check that all the registers and returns are clear and uncovered. See that the air filter is clean and clear. Check that someone hasn't adjusted the thermostat. If the heating issue persists, please contact your local service department.
